

Public Notice
of the Proposed Renewal of the federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) to
Marathon Ashland Petroleum LLC, Champaign

Marathon Ashland Petroleum LLC has requested that the Illinois EPA renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its petroleum products terminal located at 511 South Staley Road in Champaign. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed renewal. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Comments are requested on the proposed permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight March 9, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
