Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit  
to Oasis Industries, Inc. in Aurora

Oasis Industries, Inc. has applied for an air pollution control construction permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to modify its existing fiberglass resin production plant, by addition of new equipment and reconfiguration of existing equipment to have a single continuous conveyor production line. The facility is located at 1600 Mountain Street in Aurora. The spraying and curing of fiberglass resin material in the line will emit volatile organic material (VOM). The VOM emissions from the modified plant will not exceed the major source level of 100 tons per year and the project is not subject to state rule for Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification, 35 IAC Part 203. The plant is subject to the federal emission standards for Reinforced Plastic Composites Production, 40 CFR Part 63, and Subpart WWWW.

Based on its review of Oasis Industries, Inc.'s applications, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project is entitled to a construction permit. **The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight April 13, 2007.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
