

Public Notice
of the Proposed Issuance of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) to
Soyland Power Cooperative, Pittsfield

Soyland Power Cooperative has requested that the Illinois EPA to issue a federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its power generating plant located at Route 106 North in Pittsfield. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Comments are requested on the proposed permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 29, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
