Proposed Issuance of an Air Pollution Control Construction to
Harris Marcus Group, Inc., Chicago

Harris Marcus Group, Inc., has requested a joint construction and lifetime operating permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct eight new spray coating booths and two modified spray coating booths at its facility located at 3737 and 3757 South Ashland Avenue in Chicago. The new and modified coating lines will not be a significant source of air emissions. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the federal Clean Air Act, Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B).

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 27, 1999. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
