Proposed Revision of the Construction Permit for
Prairie State Group, Inc. in Franklin Park

Prairie State Group, Inc. has applied to the Illinois EPA to revise construction permit 06070040 for new printing presses at its facility located at 11100 Addison Avenue in Franklin Park. The company is asking that the emission limits in the permit be revised for existing and new printing presses. The project is not major under the rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21, or Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 IAC Part 203.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that the application for this project complies with applicable rules and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight July 4, 2008.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
