Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit to  
ST Services Blue Island Terminal, Blue Island

ST Services Blue Island Terminal has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its petroleum bulk terminal located at 3210 West 131<sup>st</sup> Street in Blue Island. The CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit. The Beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period.

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the federal Clean Air Act, and Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B).

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of this permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight January 14, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in this permit, a hearing may be held.
