Proposed Issuance of a Clean Air Act Permit Program (Title V) Permit to
Corn Products International, Inc., Bedford Park

Corn Products International, Inc., has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its Argo Manufacturing facility located at 6400 Archer Avenue in Bedford Park. The facility is involved in the processing of raw corn into a variety of products including sweeteners, starches, edible oils, and animal feeds. The CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. This permit may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making it a combined CAAPP and Title I permit.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of this permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight May 8, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in this permit, a hearing may be held.
