Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program (Title V) Permit to  
Natural Gas Pipeline Company, Herscher

Natural Gas Pipeline Company has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its natural gas compressor station located in Herscher. The CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit.
