Notice of Public Comment Period
Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit
Saint-Gobain Containers, Inc. in Dolton

The Illinois EPA is proposing to issue a construction permit to Saint-Gobain Containers, Inc. that would allow the company to modify and add controls on three of the glass furnaces at its facility located at 13850 Cottage Grove Avenue in Dolton. Two of the furnaces will increase capacity and a control system will be installed to control air emissions from all three furnaces. The project is not a major new project or modification for purposes of the state rules for Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 IAC Part 203 or the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21. Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable air pollution control regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight June 19, 2013.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing or other informational meeting may be held.
