

Public Notice
of the Proposed Revision of the Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) for
Rockford Blacktop Construction Company, New Milford

Rockford Blacktop Construction Company has requested that the Illinois EPA revise the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) previously issued for its asphalt plant located at 3663 Baxter Road in New Milford. The revision would allow the company to increase its production. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
