Proposed Revision of the Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) for
Sunnyside Corporation, Wheeling

Sunnyside Corporation has requested a revision to the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its chemical blending and processing operations at its facility located at 225 Carpenter Avenue in Wheeling. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Comments are requested on the proposed permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight March 17, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
