Notice of Public Comment Period for the
Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Graphic Packaging International, Inc. in Carol Stream

Graphic Packaging International, Inc. has applied to the Illinois EPA Bureau of Air for a construction permit to build two new printing presses at its facility located at 400 East North Avenue in Carol Stream. The facility will also be discontinuing use of lithographic press #4 as part of the project. Because of contemporaneous decreases in emissions at the plant including discontinuation of lithographic press #4, the project will not be a major modification for purposes of the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21 or the state rules for Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 IAC Part 203.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight October 9, 2011.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing or other public meeting may be held.
