Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to  
API Industries, Inc., Elk Grove Village

API Industries, Inc., has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct a new metal parts coating line and curing oven at its facility located at 1250 Morse Avenue in Elk Grove Village. The project will not be subject to federal "Prevention of Significant Deterioration" (40 CFR 52.21) rules. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit.
