Notice of Public Comment Period for the
Proposed Revision of the Construction Permit for
Big River Resources - Galva

Big River Resources - Galva, 15210 - 103rd Street, West Burlington, Iowa, has applied to the Illinois EPA Bureau of Air for a revision to the construction permit for its fuel ethanol manufacturing plant located at 1100 SE 2nd Street in Galva. The revision would increase the production of the plant to 130 million gallons of ethanol per year. The plant was originally permitted to produce 110 million gallons per year. The revision would also increase the permitted levels of plant emissions and amounts of grain processed, feed produced, and ethanol shipped from the plant. The revision would not entail construction of new process equipment and facilities. The revision would not make the plant a major new source for purposes of the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that revisions to the permit requested by Big River will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this application. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight June 10, 2011.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
