Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Fulton Ethanol, L.L.C. in Fulton

Fulton Ethanol, L.L.C. has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct an ethanol manufacturing plant to be located at 3307 4th Street in Fulton. The project would have a nominal design capacity of 113.4 million gallons per year of denatured ethanol and would use natural gas as fuel. The project would not be a major new source of air emissions as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight February 29, 2008.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
