Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program Permits to
Degussa/Goldschmidt Chemical Corporation in Mapleton and
CNH Global N.V./Case in Goodfield

Degussa/Goldschmidt Chemical Corporation has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for air emissions from its surface active agent manufacturing facility located at 8300 West Route 24 in Mapleton. Major sources of air emissions are required by the 1990 Amendments to the Clean Air Act to obtain Title V permits. The permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the public, as well as the Illinois EPA. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. This permit may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making them combined Title V and Title I permits.

CNH Global N.V./Case has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for air emissions from its agricultural implements and equipment manufacturing facility located at Route 150 East in Goodfield. Major sources of air emissions are required by the 1990 Amendments to the Clean Air Act to obtain Title V permits. The permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the public, as well as the Illinois EPA. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. This permit may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making them combined Title V and Title I permits.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permits.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permits. Comments must be postmarked by midnight April 23, 2003. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
