This permit is hereby granted to the above-designated Permittee to OPERATE emission source(s) and/or air pollution control equipment consisting of a distilled spirits plant consisting of gin processing line, vodka processing line and Smirnoff processing line, one (1) 1.95 mmBtu/hr natural gas fired water heater, two (2) 21.75 mmBtu/hr natural gas fired boilers pursuant to the above-referenced application. This Permit is subject to standard conditions attached hereto and the following special condition(s)

- 1a. This federally enforceable state operating permit is issued to limit the emissions of air pollutants from the source to less than major source thresholds (i.e., volatile organic material (VOM) to less than 25 tons per year). As a result the source is excluded from the requirement to obtain a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit. The maximum emissions of this source, as limited by the conditions of this permit, are described in Attachment A.
- b. Prior to issuance, a draft of this permit has undergone a public notice and comment period.
- c. This permit supersedes all operating permits issued for this location.
- 2a. Operation and emissions of the distilled spirits plant and boilers shall not exceed the following limits:

i. The distilled spirits plant:

- b. These limits define the potential emissions of the distilled spirits plant operation and are based on the actual emissions determined from maximum permitted production capacity and standard emission factors.
- c. Compliance with annual limits shall be determined on a monthly basis from the sum of the data for the current month plus the preceding 11 months.
3. The Permittee shall maintain monthly records of the following items:
 - a. Finished product production (gallons/month and gallons/year); and
 - b. Natural gas usage converted into Therms of fuel (therms/month and therms/year).
4. All records and logs required by this permit shall be retained at a readily accessible location at the source for at least three years from the date of entry and shall be made available for inspection and copying by the Illinois EPA or USEPA upon request. Any records retained in an electronic format (e.g., computer) shall be capable of being retrieved and printed on paper during normal source office hours so as to be able to respond to an Illinois EPA or USEPA request for records during the course of a source inspection.
5. If there is an exceedance of the requirements of this permit as determined by the records required by this permit, the Permittee shall submit a report to the Illinois EPA's Compliance Section in Springfield, Illinois within 30 days after the exceedance. The report shall include the emissions released in accordance with the recordkeeping requirements, a copy of the relevant records, and a description of the exceedance or violation and efforts to reduce emissions and future occurrences.
6. The Permittee shall submit the following additional information with the Annual Emissions Report, due May 1st of each year:
 - a. Finished product production (gallons); and
 - b. Natural gas fuel usage (therms).
7. Two (2) copies of required reports and notifications concerning equipment operation or repairs, performance testing or a continuous monitoring system shall be sent to:

Attachment A - Emission Summary

This attachment provides a summary of the maximum emissions from the liquid blending and bottling source operating in compliance with the requirements of this federally enforceable permit. In preparing this summary, the Illinois EPA used the annual operating scenario which results in maximum emissions from such a plant. This is producing 31,276,769 gallons per year of finished product. The resulting maximum emissions are well below the levels, e.g., 25 tons per year of VOM, at which this source would be considered a major source for purposes of the Clean Air Act Permit Program. Actual emissions from this source will be less than predicted in this summary to the extent that less material is handled, less proof gallons are used, and control measures are more effective than required in this permit.
