Proposed Revision of the Clean Air Act Permit Program (Title V) Permit to
Bushnell Municipal Electric Light and Power

Bushnell Municipal Electric Light and Power has requested a revision to its Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its power plant located at 175 Charles Street in Bushnell. The CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. This permit may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making it a combined CAAPP and Title I permit. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permits. The permit is being revised to address the operation of two additional engine generators at the facility.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 27, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
