Proposed Issuance of a State Construction Permit to
The City of Casey

The City of Casey has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a permit to construct six reciprocating internal combustion engines to provide power during peak demand. Three engines will be located at 201 South Central Avenue and three at 1005 South Central Avenue. The engines would not constitute a major new source of air emissions pursuant to the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight May 30, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
