Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit to  
University of Chicago, Chicago

The University of Chicago has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for operations at its university campus located at 6101 South Blackstone Avenue in Chicago. Currently, the University of Chicago is operating pursuant to state operating permits. The CAAPP permit will supersede the state operating permits. Unlike the state operating permits, the CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA.

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the federal Clean Air Act, and Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution, 35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B.

Persons wanting more information may review the Illinois EPA's project summary and draft permit and the permit application at the Illinois EPA's offices at 1701 First Avenue, Maywood, and 1340 North Ninth St., Springfield. Copies of the documents will be made available upon request.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of this permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight June 23, 1997. If sufficient interest is expressed in this permit, a hearing may be held.
