Proposed Issuance of an Air Pollution Control Construction Permit and
Notice of Public Hearing
for Calumet Energy Team, LLC, Chicago

Calumet Energy Team, LLC has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct a natural gas fired peaker power plant at either 10301 South Doty Ave. or 116th and Torrence Ave. in Chicago (The company is still working in conjunction with the City of Chicago to choose the site for the plant.) The plant would have two natural gas fired turbines to produce up to 305 MW of electricity. The plant would not be a major new source of emissions pursuant to the rules for "Prevention of Significant Deterioration" (40 CFR 52.21) or "Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification" (35 IAC Part 203) rules.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, April 26, 2000, at 7:00 p.m. at the Trumble Field House, 2400 East 105th Street in Chicago. The hearing will be held by the Illinois EPA to receive comments and data and to answer questions from the public prior to making a final decision concerning the permits. Lengthy comments and questions should be submitted to the Illinois EPA in writing. Written comments must be postmarked by midnight May 11, 2000. Comments need not be notarized and should be sent to the Hearing Officer, see address below.

The hearing will be held under the provisions of Subpart A of the Illinois EPA's "Procedures for Permit and Closure Plans" 35 Ill. Adm. Code 166. All questions about the hearing procedure, requests for copies of the hearing rules, or requests for special needs interpreters should be directed to the Hearing Officer, address below. Requests for special needs interpreters must be made to the Hearing Officer by April 10, 2000.
