Proposed Issuance of a Joint Construction and Operating Permit
to the City of Springfield (CWLP)

The City of Springfield has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct three diesel fired internal combustion engines to supply auxiliary power at the CWLP station at 3100 Stevenson Drive in Springfield. The construction and operation of the engines requires a permit because of its associated air emissions. The project will not be a major modification as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 12, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
