

Public Notice
of the Proposed Renewal of Federally Enforceable State Operating Permits (FESOP) for
NB/Microseal a Division of Bell & Howell, Zion and
Victory Memorial Hospital, Waukegan

NB/Microseal has requested that the Illinois EPA renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its printing operations located at 2000 Lewis Avenue in Zion. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Victory Memorial Hospital has requested that the Illinois EPA renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its hospital operations located at 1324 North Sheridan Road in Waukegan. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
