

**ACID RAIN PROGRAM**  
**NOTICE OF DRAFT PHASE II PERMIT AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) is proposing to issue a five year Acid Rain Phase II Permit for City, Water, Light and Power, Interstate Turbine Cordova Energy Company LLC located at 24712 192nd Ave. N. in Cordova consistent with Section 39.5(17)(b), Title IV; Acid Rain Provisions, of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act [415 ILCS 5/1 et Seq.] and Titles IV and V of the Clean Air Act.

The acid rain permit contains provisions related to sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) emissions and requires the owners and operators to hold SO<sub>2</sub> allowances to account for SO<sub>2</sub> emissions beginning in the year 2000. An allowance is a limited authorization to emit up to one ton of SO<sub>2</sub> during or after a specified calendar year. Although this plant was not eligible for an allowance allocated by USEPA, the owners or operators may obtain SO<sub>2</sub> allowances to cover emissions from other sources under a marketable allowance program.

This permit would not affect the Cordova Energy Company LLC's responsibility to meet all applicable local, state, and federal requirements. Cordova Energy Company LLC selected Mr. Gary Hood as the designated representative for the source, which includes combustion turbine units 1 and 2. Mr. Kevin Beavers was selected as the alternate designated representative for the source, which includes combustion turbine units 1 and 2.
