Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit
to CITGO Petroleum Corporation, Lemont

CITGO Petroleum Corporation has applied for a construction permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its Tier 2 Project at its refinery located at 135th Street and New Avenue in Lemont. The Tier 2 Project will enable the refinery to produce low sulfur gasoline as required by federal regulation "Tier 2 Motor Vehicle Emissions Standards and Gasoline Sulfur Control Requirements." The project will allow the refinery to remove sulfur from certain streams that are currently not treated at the level required to produce low-sulfur gasoline. This will be done by making changes to the FCC Gasoline Splitter, Heavy FCC Gasoline Hydrotreater and Light FCC Gasoline Merox Treater, and the addition of a new FCC Gasoline Hydrotreater. The changes will not result in an increase in crude throughput. The project will not be a major modification as defined by the state's rules for Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 IAC 203 or the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 12, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
