

Public Notice  
of the Proposed Renewal of the Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP)  
for Ingersoll Products Company, Chicago

Ingersoll Products Company has requested that the Illinois EPA renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for the air emissions from its agricultural disk manufacturing plant located at 1000 West 120<sup>th</sup> Street in Chicago. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the renewal. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Comments are requested on the draft permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight October 13, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
