

Public Notice
of the Proposed Renewal of the Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit
for Behr Beloit in South Beloit

Behr Beloit has requested that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for air emissions at its automotive scrap processing facility located at 201 Wheeler Avenue in South Beloit. Pursuant to the 1990 amendments to the Clean Air Act, the facility is required to have a federally enforceable permit for its air emissions. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit.

Comments are requested on the draft permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 30, 2002. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
