

Public Notice
of the Proposed Renewal of Federally Enforceable State Operating Permits (FESOP) to
PCS Phosphate Company, Inc., Marseilles, and
Commonwealth Edison Company, Marseilles

PCS Phosphate Company, Inc., has requested that the Illinois EPA renew a federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its mono and dicalcium phosphate production plant located on US Route 6 East in Marseilles. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed renewal. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

Commonwealth Edison Company has requested that the Illinois EPA renew a federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its LaSalle County generating station located at 2601 North 21st Road in Marseilles. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed renewal. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
