Proposed Issuance of an Air Pollution Control Construction Permit
to Owens-Brockway Glass Container, Inc., Streator

Owens-Brockway Glass Container, Inc., has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a construction permit to replace an old glass furnace with a new glass furnace at their facility located at 901 North Shabbona Street in Streator. There would not be a significant increase in emissions because the removal of the old furnace would offset emissions from the new furnace. The projects are not considered to be significant modifications pursuant to the "Prevention of Significant Deterioration" (40 CFR 52.21) rules. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed issuance of the draft permits.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight March 15, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
