Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit
to Greif Brothers Corporation, Alsip

Greif Brothers Corporation has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct three new coating lines at its facility located at 4300 West 130th Street in Alsip. The new coating lines would consist of six spray booths, three drying ovens and a silk screening operation. The construction of the proposed lines requires a permit because of its associated air emissions. The project will not be a major modification as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21 or the state Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification rules, 35 IAC 203. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 1, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
