Notice of Public Comment Period for the
Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Jo-Carroll Energy, Inc. in Thomson

Jo-Carroll Energy, Inc., 793 U.S. Route 20 West, Elizabeth, Illinois, 61028, has applied to the Illinois EPA Bureau of Air for a construction permit to build a wood and other biomass fuel-fired power plant at 4341 Sand Ridge Road in Thomson. The project would not be a major new source for purposes of the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight June 3, 2011.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
