Proposed Renewal of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit to  
Bell Packaging Corporation, South Holland

Bell Packaging Corporation, doing business as Visy Packaging, has requested that the Illinois EPA renew its federally enforceable state operating permit for its packaging plant located at 300 West 170<sup>th</sup> Street in South Holland. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed renewal of the permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.
