Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit
to the City of Red Bud Power Plant

The City of Red Bud has applied for a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct two new distillate fuel oil fired internal combustion engines to supply auxiliary power at the city's power plant located at 525 Power Street in Red Bud. The construction requires a permit because of the potential air emissions of the engines. The project will not be a major modification as defined by the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 22, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
