Proposed Issuance of a Lifetime Operating Permit to  
Snap-On Tools Corporation in Mt. Carmel

Snap-On Tools Corporation has requested that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency issue a Lifetime Operating Permit for the air emissions from its two boilers located at the facility at 1200 West 7<sup>th</sup> Street in Mt. Carmel. The facility formerly was issued a Clean Air Act Permit Program Permit (CAAPP) as a major source of air emissions. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit.

Comments are requested on the draft permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 27, 2005. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
