Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Clear Lam Packaging, Inc., Elk Grove Village

Clear Lam Packaging, Inc., has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct a new printing press at its facility located at 1950 Pratt Boulevard in Elk Grove Village. The construction permit would include federally enforceable limitations that restrict air emissions so that the project would not be a major modification as defined in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 203. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight April 12, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
