Proposed Issuance of Clean Air Act Permit Program (Title V) Permit to
Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. – Dolton Recycle Center

Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. has requested a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its solvent recycling/recovering center located at 633 East 138th Street in Dolton. The CAAPP permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of this permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight February 12, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in this permit, a hearing may be held.
