Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Great Lakes Naval Training Center

Great Lakes Naval Training Center has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a permit to build a cogeneration facility to be located at the Naval Training Center on Isherwood Avenue in Great Lakes. The construction requires a permit because the facility will be a source of air emissions. Emissions from the facility will not exceed major source levels and therefore the project is not subject to the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight May 14, 2003. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
