Proposed Renewal of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) for
Midstate Core Company, Decatur

Midstate Core Company has requested that the Illinois EPA renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its sand core manufacturing equipment located at its facility at 225 North Hilton in Decatur. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the Federal Clean Air Act, and Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B.)

Comments are requested on the proposed permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight May 19, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
