Proposed Issuance of an Air Pollution Control Construction Permit
to Clear Lam Packaging, Inc., Elk Grove Village

Clear Lam Packaging, Inc., has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a revision to their construction permit reflecting the addition of three flexographic presses to their facility located at 1950 Pratt Boulevard in Elk Grove Village. The revised permit would include limitations constraining emissions for the three presses as well as presses and laminators plant-wide so that this construction will not be a major increase in emission pursuant to New Source Review, 35 IAC Part 203. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed issuance of the draft permits.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight March 6, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
