Notice of Public Comment Period for the
Proposed Issuance of a Construction Permit to
Tate & Lyle in Decatur

Tate & Lyle Decatur has applied to the Illinois EPA Bureau of Air for a construction permit to build a fifth feed dryer at its facility located at 2200 East Eldorado Street in Decatur. The new dryer would operate along with the four existing steam tube dryers in the feed house to dry feed material that is a byproduct of the wet corn mill at the source. This project would also include improvements in emission controls for the existing feed dryers that would result in a large reduction in emissions of volatile organic material (VOM). The project would not be a major new source for purposes of the federal rules for Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD), 40 CFR 52.21.

Based on its review of the application, the Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that this project will comply with the applicable environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on the application for this project. **Comments must be postmarked by midnight October 2, 2011.** If sufficient interest is expressed in this matter, a hearing may be held.
