Proposed Issuance of an revised Air Pollution Control Construction Permit for
Allied Tube and Conduit Corporation, Harvey

Allied Tube and Conduit Corporation has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a revision to its construction permit for Mill #9 at its facility located at 16100 South Lathrop Avenue in Harvey. The revision would allow the company to “net” emission reductions at the facility so that the construction is not a major modification to the facility and the facility would not be required to get 1.3 to 1 emission reductions pursuant to 35 IAC 203. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed issuance of the revision to the previously issued construction permit.

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the permit application and has concluded that the application complies with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the federal Clean Air Act, and Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B).

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight January 4, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
