Proposed Renewal of Federally Enforceable State Operating Permits (FESOP) for  
Freesen Inc., Curran and  
P.H. Broughton & Sons, Inc., Springfield

Freesen Inc., has requested that the Illinois EPA renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its asphalt plant located on Rural Route Curran in Curran. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

P.H. Broughton & Sons, Inc., has requested that the Illinois EPA renew the federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for its asphalt plant located at 905 North Lincoln Avenue in Springfield. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit. The permit will contain federally enforceable limitations that restrict the facility's emissions to non-major levels. The permit will be enforceable by the USEPA, as well as the Illinois EPA.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) has reviewed the permit applications and has concluded that the applications comply with applicable state and federal air pollution control laws and rules, including the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the federal Clean Air Act, and Illinois' Rules for Air Pollution (35 Ill. Adm. Code: Subtitle B.)
