Proposed Revision of the Clean Air Act Permit Program (Title V) Permit for
ST Services Blue Island Terminal

ST Services Blue Island Terminal has requested a significant modification to the Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit issued to the facility on February 7, 2001 by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for air emissions from its petroleum bulk terminal at 3210 West 131st Street in Blue Island. The significant modification would allow for the storage of volatile organic liquids and volatile petroleum liquids in a greater range of storage tanks currently at the facility. As a major source of air emissions, the company is required by the 1990 Amendments to the Clean Air Act to have a CAAPP permit. The permit may be enforced by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA. The beginning of this public comment period also serves as the beginning date of the USEPA 45 day review period, provided the USEPA does not seek a separate proposed period. This permit may contain terms and conditions established pursuant to Title I of the federal Clean Air Act thereby making it a combined CAAPP and Title I permit. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the revision.

Comments are requested on the proposed modification of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 8, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in a permit, a hearing may be held.
