

Notice of Public Hearing and Comment Period
Concerning Proposed Issuance of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit to
Arrow Road Construction Company in Carpentersville

Arrow Road Construction Company has requested that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency issue a federally enforceable state operating permit (FESOP) for the air emissions from its asphalt plant located at 33 W 760 Bolz Road in Carpentersville. The facility was previously owned by and known as Callaghan Asphalt. The 1990 amendments to the Clean Air Act require potentially major sources of air emissions to obtain federally enforceable operating permits. A FESOP permit allows a source that is potentially major to take operational limits in the permit so that it is a non-major source. The permit will be enforceable by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, as well as the Illinois EPA.

The Illinois EPA will hold a public hearing on May 17, 2005 at 7:00 pm at the Dundee Crown High School auditorium, 1500 Kings Road in Carpentersville. The hearing will be held to receive comments and answer questions from the public prior to making a final decision concerning the draft permit. The hearing will be held under the Illinois EPA's "Procedures for Permit and Closure Plans," 35 IAC 166, Subpart A. Lengthy comments and questions should be submitted in writing. Requests for interpreters (including sign language) must be made by May 3, 2005. Written comments must sent to the Hearing Officer and be postmarked by midnight, June 16, 2005, unless otherwise specified by the Hearing Officer. Written comments need not be notarized.
