Proposed Revision to a Construction Permit for  
Crown Cork and Seal Company, Inc., Aurora

Crown Cork and Seal Company, Inc. has applied for a revision to a construction permit issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for its facility located at 3737 East Exchange Avenue in Aurora. As originally issued the permit allowed revision of the emission limits and replacement of Can Sheet Coater #1, the new permit would also allow the revision of emission limits for Can Sheet Coater #2. The project will not be a major modification as defined by the state's rules for Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 IAC 203 or the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 CFR 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project. Comments must be postmarked by midnight March 27, 2002. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
