Proposed Issuance of a State Construction Permit to
Chicago Heights Steel, Chicago Heights

Chicago Heights Steel has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a permit to construct a new coating line (line #3) at its facility located at 211 East Main Street in Chicago Heights. The addition of the new coating line along with contemporaneous decreases in air emissions at the facility will not constitute a major modification under 35 IAC Part 203, Major Stationary Source Construction. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight January 9, 2001. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
