Proposed Issuance of a State Joint Construction and Operating Permit to  
Devonshire Power Partners, L.L.C., Dolton

Devonshire Power Partners, L.L.C., has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a permit to construct and operate an electricity generator run on landfill gas at 138<sup>th</sup> and Cottage Grove Avenue in Dolton. The facility will not be a new major source of air emissions pursuant to the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight November 25, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
