Proposed Issuance of a State Joint Construction and Lifetime Operating Permit to
Cedar Components, North Aurora

Cedar Components has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) for a permit to construct and operate a wood coating plant at 50 South Street in North Aurora. The company is proposing to restrict its production rate so that it will not be a major new source of air emissions. The facility is not subject to the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) rules, 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 52.21. The Illinois EPA is accepting comments prior to making a final decision on this project.

Comments are requested on the proposed issuance of the permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight December 4, 2000. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
