Public Notice
of the Proposed Issuance of a Lifetime Operating Permit to
Metals Technology Corporation in Carol Stream

Metals Technology Corporation has requested that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency issue a Lifetime Operating Permit regulating the air emissions from its heat treating plant at 120 North Schmale Road in Carol Stream. Lifetime Operating Permits are issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to sources that are not major or potentially major sources of air emissions. The Illinois EPA has made a preliminary determination that the application would comply with the environmental regulations and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the draft permit. Comments must be postmarked by midnight January 10, 2009. If sufficient interest is expressed in the permit, a hearing may be held.
