

**Public Notice**  
**Proposed Issuance of a State Construction Permit**  
**and Notice of Public Hearing for**  
**North Shore Sanitary District, Waukegan**

North Shore Sanitary District has requested a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) to construct a sludge processing facility consisting of sludge receiving and storage area, drying process, and a melting process on Dahringer Road in Waukegan. The project would not be a major source of air emissions pursuant to the federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration rules (40 CFR52.21) or the Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification rules (35 IAC 203). The Illinois EPA is accepting comments on the proposed permit.

The Illinois EPA will hold a public hearing on October 3, 2001 at 7:00 p.m. in the Wixom Theater at the Ninth Grade Center, 1011 Washington Street in Waukegan. The hearing will be held by the Illinois EPA to receive comments and data and to answer questions from the public prior to making a final decision concerning the permit. Lengthy comments and questions should be submitted to the Illinois EPA in writing. Written comments must be postmarked by midnight, November 3, 2001, unless otherwise specified by the hearing officer at the time of the hearing. Comments need not be notarized and should be sent to the Illinois EPA Hearing Officer, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.
